

- ²³ Ages ago I was set up, at the first, before the beginning of the earth.
- ²⁴ When there were no depths I was brought forth, when there were no springs abounding with water.
- 25 Before the mountains had been shaped, before the hills, I was brought forth 26 when he had not yet made earth and fields, or the world's first bits of soil.

SECOND READING ROMANS 5:1-5



### Drawn into Relationship, Guided into Truth

The doctrine of the Trinity invites us to consider how a God constituted by relationship—the Father with the Son, the Son with the Spirit, the Spirit with the Father—draws us into that relationship with God and one another. Gradually or suddenly, through the work of the Spirit, we come to know our belonging to the Father and to Christ's body.

In such loving relationships, truth is discovered. But people cannot bear

the truth all at once, so formation are gradual the Spirit's voice. as worship, learning, and people of all ages to be practices are rooted in draws us into a lifelong



discipleship and faith processes of listening for Christian practices such service are occasions for "guided into truth." Such baptism, in which God relationship in which we
