As Lutherans, we believe that we are part of God's unfolding plan. When we gather for worship, we connect with believers everywhere. When we study the Bible or hear God's word in worship, we are drawn more deeply into God's own saving story.



A Reflection from Pastor Rob The Story of Jesus. The Story of Us.

Then the woman left her water jar and went back to the city. She said to the people, "Come and see a man who told me everything I have ever done!" John 4:28-29

For many of us in the Christian tradition, Lent is a time of self-reflection and introspection. On the one hand, we sing more reflective hymns and refrain from saying "halleluia" in worship. On the other hand, we might give up an indulgence – like chocolate – or add Bible study to our daily routine.

Regardless of your observation, the mood of Lent is often quiet and reflective. We are called to evaluate our lives in faith.

The season of Lent is not that much different from the Samaritan woman's meeting with Jesus at the well in John 4. There, the woman was confronted with her life struggle of marriage and relationships. In response, Jesus offers her living waters of faith and purpose that no other person can offer.

Amazed and transformed by Jesus' words, the Samaritan woman runs to her neighborhood and tells everyone she meets about Jesus. She is a witness to Jesus' power and grace. By telling others her experience with Jesus, she is turning Jesus' story into her story. She began her relationship with Jesus in a moment of self-reflection (just like Lent). Her relationship transforms into a life of grace and salvation. She is crucified; she is raised from the dead.

This Lenten season, we will explore the story of Jesus. More importantly, in sermons and in Bible study, we will talk about ways that the story of Jesus is the story of us.

Think about your story of faith – seasons when you felt alone or defeated, and seasons when you have felt rejuvenated, alive, and blessed. How will you go and tell others the story of Jesus – the story of us!


