


Join us on Sunday, September 10, for our annual Rally Day/Church Picnic.

- Issues

- New Sliding Doors
 - Clay discussed how our new sliding doors would operate, locking/unlocking, set on automatic, being locked in, etc.
 - We will go with Toledo Mirror & Glass Automated Entrance Technology approximately \$17,620 (Toledo, Ohio)
 - 3-Panel Telescoping Door
 - 67-1/2" opening
 - $\circ~$ Estimates do not include getting power to the door.
 - There will be a display set up so the congregation can see what the doors would look like.
- Installing a Knox Box will be put on hold until after new doors would be installed. Bryant will see about smoke alarms to be installed soon.
